A. Project Background

Government of Bangladesh is implementing the Skills for Employment Investment Program (SEIP) with financial assistance from the Asian Development Bank (ADB) and Swiss Agency for Development and Cooperation (SDC) that will develop a workforce equipped with contemporary technical skills and knowledge through vocational training by establishing a mechanism to facilitate collaboration between training institutes and industry which would optimize the utilization of available human resources.

The program will work in close coordination with the National Skill Development Council (NSDE) secretariat. The program will also work in close collaboration with a number of training institutes under different ministries, selected industry associations, BBSME and PKSF in SEIP priority sectors (RMG and textiles, construction, light engineering, information technology). The program will have linkages with on-going projects supported by government and development partners including Skills Development Project, Skills Training Enhancement Project, etc.

The Skills Development Coordination and Monitoring Unit (SDCMU) has been established under the Finance Division, Ministry of Finance to serve as the Program Management Unit (PMU) of the SEIP. Finance Division of the Ministry of Finance is the executing agency for the SEIP. NSDC is going to be supported through SEIP Project.

The purpose of this assignment is to lead the Industry Skill Council (ISC) activity in National Skill Development Council Secretariat (NSDC-S) and to drive and operationalize MIS and M&E in National Skill Development Council Secretariat (NSDC-S).
